



















Below are some suggestions for activities linked to Curriculum for Wales which you may like to complete at home. If your child wishes you can share any of the activities they complete by sending a photograph via Dojo messages to their class teacher. Begin the day by reading Room on the Broom if you have a copy at home or watch the animation on BBC iPlayer.





Imagine you are on a broom flying off to different places. Where would you go? Innovate (change) the Room on the Broom story to include your ideas.

Languages, Literacy and Communication

Snuggle with your family / cuddly toys and share your favourite story.

Practise reading and spelling your Dolch words.

Mathematics & Numeracy

Practise counting in steps of 2s, 5s and 10s. (extend to 3s and 4s if ready)

Year 2: write out and practise your x2, x5 and x10 times tables

Mathematics & Numeracy

Create a table with each of the characters from the story. Read or watch the story and record on your table how many times each character is mentioned. Which character is the most? least?





Go for a walk with a grown-up and take a camera to capture your journey. Where did you go? Who / what did you see?

Expressive Arts

Use just your fingers and hands to create a broomstick picture. When it is dry add the details using a black pen.
