<p><b>Health &amp; Well-Being</b></p> <p>Go for a walk with a grown-up and take a camera to capture some lovely winter photographs.</p> <p>Work on your throwing skills by throwing snowballs at a target.</p>	<p><b>Expressive Arts</b></p> <p>Write in the snow. Add food colouring to a spray bottle filled with water, or use a paintbrush, and make some designs in the snow.</p> <p>Can you build a for sledge for your Lego character / Barbie / small world character? Use items you find around your house and in your toy box.</p>	<p><b>Humanities</b></p> <p>Become a detective and search for animal footprints in the snow.</p> <p>Research different countries around the World and what weather they are experiencing in February 2024. Do they have snow like us?</p>	<p><b>Science &amp; Technology</b></p> <p>Build a family of snowmen of different sizes. Watch throughout the day what happens to them? Do they take the same amount of time to melt? Which size melts the quickest? Why do you think this is?</p>
