Snacks

We encourage good table manners. You will not be additionally for this.

Child Care & Parent Contracts

Before your child/rem attends Acorns we require a Childcare & Parent Contracts to be filled in and returned, this provides us with vital information such as contact numbers, dietary requirements and medical needs. There is an additional space to provide your child's likes and dislikes, this helps us to get to know your child and plan activities that we engage your child.

Acorns Areas

We have a large classroom which are based, a wet area for craft activities, the hall for indoor sports ,canteen for snack, games, pool and role play area we also have access to both school yards and the field when the weather is nice.



Cancellations

Please inform Acorns staff as soon as possible when cancelling a place. Its important as we need to know for our staff to child ratios. There will be a charge of ± 3.30 (first hour charge) if you have not cancelled your child's place 24 hours in advance.

Medical Information

If your child has any medical conditions such as an allergy or any dietary information, this needs to be stated on childcare contracts.



First Aid

Acorns staff hold first aid certificates and are trained. When an accident or incident happens during Acorns, a form will be filled in by a member of staff. The form includes brief details, any injury and action taken by the member of staff. The form is filled in as soon as it happens a, when you arrive to pick up your child you will be informed and asked to sign the form.

Quality of Care Report

The Quality of Care Report is done by Chelsea every 12 months. Evidence such as photos, questionnaires and posters will be collected over the 12 months previously. We like to include feedback from Parents/ guardians, children and staff. When the Report is finished it will be displayed on the notice board it or have a copy. Please ask Chelsea.

Activities and Games
