Snacks

Owls provide the children with a snack as they arrive for the afternoon session, they have a choice of fruit, milk or water and a cracker or breadstick. The children sit down together in the canteen to eat their snack while having a chat with friends. We also provide a snack at 5:00pm, the children sit down together at a table to eat. We encourage good table manners. You will not be additionally for this.

Cancellations

Please inform Owls staff as soon as possible when cancelling a place. Its important as we need to know for our staff to child ratios. There will be a charge of £3.30 (first hour charge) if you have not cancelled your child's place 24 hours in advance.

Medical information

If your child has any medical conditions such as an allergy or any dietary information, this needs to be stated on childcare contracts.

First aid

Owls staff hold first aid certificates and are trained. When an accident or incident happens during Owls, a form will be filled in by a member of staff. The form includes brief details, any injury and action taken by the member of staff. The form is filled in as soon as it happens a, when you arrive to pick up your child you will be informed and asked to sign the form.

Ouality of Care Report

The Quality of Care Report is done by Chelsea every 12 months. Evidence such as photos, questionnaires and posters will be collected over the 12 months previously. We like to include feedback from Parents/ guardians, children and staff. When the Report is finished it will be displayed on the notice board it or have a copy. Please ask Chelsea.
